### DAY 18

**Romans 12:9-12** [The Voice Translation] “Love others well, and don’t hide behind a mask; love authentically. Despise evil; pursue what is good as if your life depends on it. <sup>10</sup> Live in true devotion to one another, loving each other as sisters and brothers. Be first to honor others by putting them first. <sup>11</sup> Do not slack in your faithfulness and hard work. Let your spirit be on fire, bubbling up and boiling over, as you serve the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Do not forget to rejoice, for hope is always just around the corner. Hold up through the hard times that are coming and devote yourselves to prayer. <sup>13</sup> Share what you have with the saints, so they lack nothing; take every opportunity to open your life and home to others.”

Matthew 6:33 says to, “seek first the Kingdom of God.” In seeking first, the Kingdom of God, you will find that honoring others is a major part of living in God’s Kingdom. We are encouraged and commanded to “be the first” to put others, first! This word, “honor,” means to value, to respect, to give worth, and to esteem. Too many times we miss the opportunity that God has placed before us to “be the first” to give a person the respect that is due them.

Honoring another individual is placing value upon them. It makes a statement to them that they have worth in this life. Our lives are so fast paced that we miss those who should be given honor and placed first.
