DAY 6

John 3:16 [The Amplified Translation] “*For God so greatly loved and dearly prized the world that He [even] gave up His only begotten (unique) Son, so that whoever believes in (trusts in, clings to, relies on) Him shall not perish (come to destruction, be lost) but have eternal (everlasting) life.*”

A friendship is a close and intimate relationship that is developed over time. It is a bond of mutual understanding, affection, and support. However, a lasting friendship also requires time and dedication. Saint Augustine said, “*To fall in love with God is the greatest romance; to seek him the greatest adventure; to find him, the greatest human achievement.*”

In a relationship there are two stalwarts, cornerstones, that exemplify what a friendship must have to last...Love and Giving. These are the foundation stones we find in John 3:16, “*God so LOVED that He GAVE.*” This is the apex of true friendship.

Loving is what ignites giving and giving is our response to others because of the love we have for them. Every strong relationship, friendship, marriage, etc., has love and giving as its foundation. We know God loves us. We know God gives, and gives, and gives to us. The great quandary for us is do we have these 2 characteristics at the core of our relationship with the Father? Do I love Him? How much do I love Him? Am I a giver in this relationship? What and how much do I give to God?

Today, make the decision to love God. Love Him, totally and entirely, love Him. Become a giver in your relationship with God. Give of yourself, all that you are and all that you have. You only have it because God gave it to you. God wants you to love Him without conditions. God wants you to give to Him without conditions. This is the way He loves us and gives to us...no conditions.
