Psalm 95:3-7 [New Living Translation] *"For **the Lord is a great God, a great King** above all gods. ⁴ He holds in His hands the depths of the earth and the mightiest mountains. ⁵ The sea belongs to Him, for He made it. His hands formed the dry land, too. ⁶ Come, let us worship and bow down. Let us kneel before the Lord our maker, ⁷ for He is our God. We are the people He watches over, the flock under His care."*

There are many aspects of our relationship with God. He is our Father. He calls us His friend. We are His children, sons, and daughters of God. He forgives our sin when we repent. He loves us. He gives to us. God wants to be intimate with us. He never leaves us, nor does He forsake us. He is always watching.
